1. On February 21, 1933, Nina was born. Nina Simone was her stage name. She hoped that adopting a different name would keep her mother from finding out about her performances, her real name was Eunice Kathleen Waymon.

2. Nina, was a nickname given to her by a boyfriend named Chico and "Simone" was taken from a French actress Simone Signoret.

3. Nina has one kid named, Lisa Simone. Lisa is now 58 years old and born on September 12, 1962. She's also an American singer like her mother.

4. Nina Simone also has a sibling named, Sam Waymon. Sam was a Musical Director and Composer for three major musicals, which are Shakespeare Festival, notably, Black Picture Show and Forbidden City.

5. In her final years, reports indicated that Nina Simone was battling breast cancer. She died at the age of 70 on April 21, 2003.
